Public Health because diseases can be prevented or treated with timely access to appropriate and affordable medication, vaccines, and other health services;


Access to Safe Water because access to clean and safe water is essential to achieve health, education and income growth, particularly for women and children;

For a better world, with PUBLIC HEALTH. Because it's vital and a human right.

The purpose of Public Health systems is to prevent disease, making it essential to each of our lives and to life in society. Diseases can be prevented or treated with timely access to appropriate health education and affordable medication, vaccines, and other health services.

However, access to health information is still far from being universal, as are the resources for preventing and treating diseases. According to a report from the World Bank and the World Health Organization, at least half of the world's population does not have access to basic and essential health services (WHO and The World Bank, "Tracking universal health coverage: 2017 global monitoring report."). The lack of equitable access to healthcare is a world crisis. The spread of the Covid-19 virus that the world is now facing is a serious new threat to the lives of each of us and to the life of all communities.

How will the most vulnerable communities survive this global pandemic?

What will happen to the communities that don't have access to information about the virus, preventive resources, basic hygiene, sanitation or medical care?

More than ever, it is urgent to support scientific research and promote education projects focused on prevention, as well as to guarantee access to hygiene and sanitation, to protective equipment and healthcare. We need to make sure that all of us are given conditions to stay healthy so that we can continue to live, learn, work and care for those who need us.

For a better world, with ACCESS TO SAFE WATER. Did you know it saves lives?

Access to safe water means life, health, education and income, especially for children and women. Still, 2.2 billion people in the world live without clean and safe drinking water
WHO and UNICEF, "1 in 3 people globally do not have access to safe drinking water".

That is nearly 3 in every 10 people worldwide. Six times the population of the United States.

According to the World Health Organization:
"The provision of safe water, sanitation and hygienic conditions is essential to protecting human health during all infectious disease outbreaks, including the COVID-19 outbreak. Ensuring good and consistently applied WASH and waste management practices in communities, homes, schools, marketplaces, prisons and health care facilities will further help to prevent human-to-human transmission of the COVID-19 virus."
WHO, "WASH and COVID-19."

Did you know that most people who don't have access to safe water live in isolated rural areas and walk for several hours a day to collect water for their families? Having to walk for water often means you are much more vulnerable to contagious diseases that can spread through an entire community, keeps children out of school, takes up time that parents could use to earn money to support their families, means danger.
